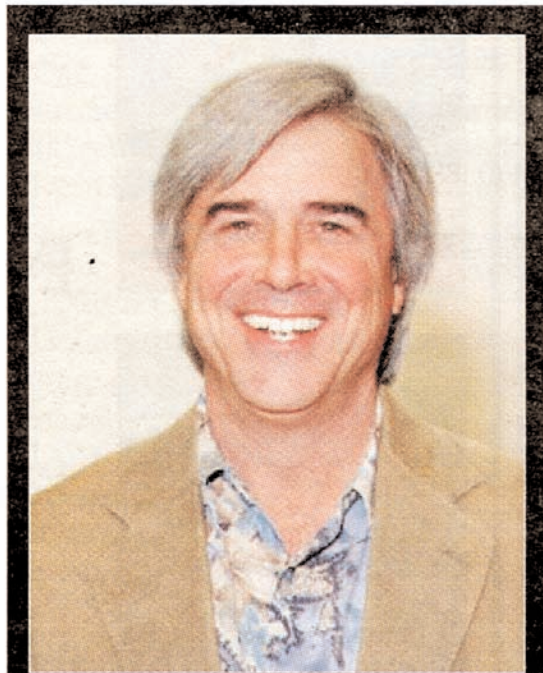

**Ford foundation** – Jazz singer **Kimberly Ford** steps into the forefront of the Santa Barbara jazz scene with CD/DVD release concert at the Santa Barbara Maritime Museum. Ford, who has been plying the underground Santa Barbara jazz scene – which means ongoing gigs singing standards at such chi-chi night spots as Stella Mare’s, the Bacara and the San Ysidro Ranch – for nearly a decade, has recorded both a new album, “Songs in the Key of Sea,” and the soundtrack for a DVD. “Key of Sea” has four originals alongside eight jazz standards, while the DVD is all original, written to accompany “Water Mark,” an underwater video produced by Emmy Award-winning underwater filmmaker and Montecito resident,

**Mike DeGruy**.
